Guest Moorage COVID-19 Restrictions

If you are ill or have any of the symptoms as described by the Washington State COVID-19 guidelines, **STAY HOME!**

When on the docks, use Washington State guidelines for proper social distancing, the use of masks, and restricting the size of social gatherings.

Payment requirements and moorage regulations are posted at the top of the ramp. Envelopes and a drop box are located at the top of the ramp.

If entering the BYC Clubhouse, observe and follow all posted restrictions and directions.

The use of face masks is required within the BYC Clubhouse at all times.

The following individuals are exempt from the requirements to wear a face covering: Children younger than five years old; and

Children who are younger than two years old should never wear face coverings due to the risk of suffocation.

Children who are two, three, or four years old, with the assistance and close supervision of an adult, are strongly recommended to wear a face covering at all times in settings, like grocery stores or pharmacies, where it is likely that a distance of at least six feet cannot be maintained from non-household members and vulnerable people must go.

Persons with a medical condition, mental health condition, developmental or cognitive condition, or disability that prevents wearing a face covering. This includes, but is not limited to, persons with a medical condition for whom wearing a face covering could obstruct breathing or who are unconscious, incapacitated, or otherwise unable to remove a face covering without assistance.

It is strongly recommended that those using **GUEST MOORAGE** utilize the toilet and bathing facilities on their own boats. The BYC shower facilities are closed to all non-BYC members at this time. Restroom facilities are available only during normal BYC Café operating hours.
